**COIA SUPPORTS DIVISION 1A FACULTY ATHLETICS REPRESENTATIVES
POSITION AGAINST A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP PLAYOFF SYSTEM IN
DIVISION 1 FBS FOOTBALL**

The NCAA Division IA Faculty Athletics Representatives (FARs) have issued a statement opposing proposals calling for a national championship playoff system in college football. The Coalition on Intercollegiate Athletics (COIA) would like to express its strong support of the FARs' position. We agree that additional post-season play is not in the best interests of the student-athlete, which should be the most important consideration in any decision regarding collegiate athletics.
